

# IREM<sup>®</sup> Diversity Scholar Program

## Program Goal

- The goal of the IREM<sup>®</sup> Diversity Board Diversity Scholar Program is to encourage active participation in IREM<sup>®</sup> by diverse members, and provide future diverse leaders exposure to IREM<sup>®</sup> at a national level.

## Availability

Complimentary registrations will be awarded for each conference during which a Diversity Board meeting will be held – currently the Leadership and Legislative Summit and IREM<sup>®</sup> Fall Leadership Conference. A total of five recipients will be chosen for each meeting.

## Eligibility

- Applicant must be a self-identified individual from an underrepresented population group
- Associate members, ARM<sup>®</sup> members, ACoM members, CPM<sup>®</sup> Candidates, and CPM<sup>®</sup> members
- Must have attended 50% of chapter functions in the past 12 months
- Active involvement in committees or boards at the chapter or national level. If the nominee is not actively involved in committees or boards, he/she must provide details of Chapter involvement and chapter recommendation. Has not attended more than one previous national conference
- Has not previously received a complimentary registration from the Diversity Board
- Applicant must provide brief detail of why he/she would like to attend the conference
- Application must be signed by chapter president.

## Selection Process

The applicant must complete and submit a Diversity Scholar Application. Nominations are accepted from current IREM<sup>®</sup> members and/or chapters. If the number of nominations exceeds the number of available complimentary registrations (currently five), the nominee list will be narrowed to the number of complimentary registrations available by a committee consisting of the Diversity Board Chair, Vice-Chair, and one other member appointed by the Chair. At that time, the final nominee list will be voted on by the Board. The Diversity Board Chair reserves the right to request additional complimentary registrations from the IREM<sup>®</sup> President on an as needed basis.

## Recipient requirement

All recipients must attend the Diversity Board Meeting held during the conference for which they receive a complimentary registration.

## Recipient will Receive

- One complimentary Registration
- A mentor assigned by the Diversity Advisory Board

## Application Deadline

January 31 for Leadership and Legislative Summit  
July 31 for the IREM<sup>®</sup> Fall Leadership Conference.
